Bursaries to attend [First RegenBell symposium on Stem Cells and Regenerative Medicine](#)
November 27-28th at the Institut d'Estudis Catalans, Barcelona, SPAIN

Deadline is midnight 25th October 2023

Up to three bursaries are intended to support scientists from stem cell resource centres in Bulgaria (public/private) who wish to attend RegenBell Symposium but do not have access to adequate funds for travel and accommodation.

Applicants may be of any age but will need to satisfy a criteria that they and their host institution would significantly benefit from attendance at RegenBell Symposium

Please note that applicants will need to:

- a) Complete the application form (see appendix)
- b) Include a letter (one page maximum) from their supervisor or host lab stating the reason for the application including the benefits to the proposed student and to the host organisation.
- c) Include a CV (one page maximum).
- d) Include a letter containing their personal justification for the application.

Bursary applications are assessed by an independent committee who will consider a number of parameters in their assessment of all applicants including the following:

- Role or proposed role of the applicant in their laboratory or stem cell banking facility
- Institutional approval and/or supervisor's support for travel (one page maximum).
- Applicant's biography including any experience in stem cell research/biobanking (one page maximum).
- Abstract submitted/accepted for short oral/poster presentation

Final decisions will be broadly based on the committee score but other factors may be considered including the overall gender balance.
