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FORMATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE REPORTS

The materials are sent to the following *e-mail*: sport_conference_su@abv.bg in DOC format, Editor Word 2000 or higher version. The proposed articles must be original and unpublished in other editions (a declaration of originality and reliability is completed).

The volume is from 5 to 15 pages of A4, including annotation, tables, graphs, bibliography, data and notes of the authors.

Page setup:

Format: A4, Portrait;

Fields: left, top, bottom, and right – 2.5 cm.

Formatting:

Alignment: Alignment Justified; no hyphenation;

Indent (new paragraph line): First Line Indent - None;

Line spacing – Single;

Paragraph spacing: Don't add space between paragraphs – 0 pt;

Font: Times New Roman; 12 p.m.

Arrangement of the report:

Author's language title: **Bold**, ALL CAPS;

Author(s): next line – first and last name of authors, **Bold**, ALL CAPS;

The title and names of the authors in English are located through 2 blank lines of all caps surname and first name of the authors, followed by the title.

Note: *If the article is written in English, the title, abstract and keywords are written in Bulgarian.*

And the abstract (Summary) in the author's language and in English are located through 1 blank row, in a volume of up to 150 words. Its contents should not be identical or match some of the text of the article.

The abstract should represent the essence of the development, method, results and conclusions of research.

Key Words follow in the next line *Italic*, in the author's language and in English, respectively. Keywords (3-6 pcs.) should not repeat the title but indicate the main problems of the study.

The main text has the following structure: introduction, survey methodology, results, conclusions and recommendations, bibliography (used and quoted in the text – indicated according to **APA**, the citation is indicated by “()”, for example (Ivanov, 2018), and at the end the used sources are numbered and arranged alphabetically according to the surname of the first author;

Tables, shapes, diagrams, pictures, and schemes (grouped): they must be in **the black and grayscale** (not full color) integrated into the text, numbered, and named. They are also applied to individual files in JPEG or TIFF format. Table headings are displayed above them and the shapes below them (Paragraph Alignment: Centered).

The formulas should be numbered with numbers in round brackets aligned to the right of them.

Bibliography (used and quoted in the text) must contain at least 15 **APA**-style **sources**. According to **APA**, the citation is indicated in the text by round brackets, and at the end the sources used are numbered and arranged alphabetically by the surname of the first author, first in Cyrillic, then in Latin. Literary sources of Cyrillic **are transliterated** by placing them in square brackets.

Authors' data and notes: At the end of the article, a blank line is:

√ notes of the author relating to funding thanks or methodological and scientific assistance, if any;

√ spell out the full names of the author (authors) with the scientific title and degree, place of work, telephone, E-mail and ID in ORCID (*Italic*, **Line Indent – 5,0**, Uppercase and Lowercase letters, Justified). If the articles contain data or results from master's, doctoral dissertations or research project reports, the consent of the authors of those works or the head of the relevant research project is required. In addition, the sources of this data and the results of the.

APPROVAL AND REVIEW OF REPORTS

In connection with the cooperation and support of *the Publishing House "Azbuki"* of the MES and the Federation of Sports Educators in the Republic of Macedonia, the regional authorities, after review, shall determine:

5-10 reports, which will be published in *the journal Vocational Education, publishing house "Azbuki"* at the *University of National and World Economy, media partner of the scientific conference*. The articles of The New Publishing Magazine "Vocational education" is referenced, indexed and li booked in ERIH PLUS, CEEOL, EBSCO, host Research Databases, Google Scholar, Ex Libris, ProQuest.

15-20 reports to be published in **journals Research in Kinesiology (RIK) и Activities in Physical Education and Sport (APES)**. The articles in the APES and RIK issued by the Federation of sports pedagogues in the Republic of Macedonia and *are presented and incorporated with a comprehensive text of: EBSCO (UNITED STATES) and •SPORTDiscus. Articles are indexed in: WorldCat; COBISS.MK /Cooperative online bibliographic system and services/; COBIB.MK /Union Cooperative Bibliographic Database/; Journals Library /Center for Social Sciences in Berlin/; Wissenschaftszentrum Berlin für Sozialforschung (WZB); GETINFO – TIB /German National Library of Science and Technology/; CHENGFINd /Library „David and Lorraine Cheng“, „William Patterson“, University of Zurich/.*

The compendium "**Modern trends of Physical Education and Sport**" publishes the other reports of the Conference. The collection is published in book and electronic format and is included in the National Reference List of modern Bulgarian scientific publications with scientific review and is published on the website of the University Library "St. Kliment Ohridski" (<http://libsu.uni-sofia.bg:81/UB/>), on the conference website (<https://sportconference.alle.bg/>) and on the website of the Department of Sport (https://www.uni-sofia.bg/Sports_Department), as well as in other scientific portals, such as Researchgate, Academia.

The publication of the submitted materials is determined by the recommendations of the reviewers and does not necessarily imply the consent of the editorial with the views advocated by the authors. Editors can edit manuscripts when needed.

The submitted works are evaluated anonymously by two independent, competent reviewers. Works can be accepted, rejected or returned to authors for correction. Suggestions for corrections are submitted by reviewers, experts, editorial board members, editor-in-chief and/or deputies of the editor-in-chief.

Reviewers:

- Objectively assess the scientific value of the manuscript, in which the names of the authors are anonymous.
- Assess reports according to the following criteria:
 - √ *Structure of the report:* Introduction, purpose, tasks, Methodology and organization of the study, Results, conclusions and recommendations.
 - √ Do the conclusions of the target fit?
 - √ Is there clarity and readability?
 - √ Are there new ideas or important results?
 - √ Is the report well illustrated?
 - √ Appropriate citation of literary sources (citation not allowed)
- They formulate their assessment on the basis of expertise and do not allow personal criticism.
- Indicate in the form where errors were made and where there are gaps.
- They provide recommendations and examples to edit the manuscript and improve its quality.
- Monitor whether the manuscript is original and authored (with an established degree of likeness exceeding 20%, the reports are not published).



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
