VELUX Scholarship Programme

What is the VELUX Scholarship Programme?

The scholarship programme is for talented, but financially disadvantaged young people (full-time university students at undegraduate level study programmes) from Bulgaria, Romania, Hungary, Slovakia, Czech Republic and Poland. They are given the opportunity to enroll at the International Business Academy for one semester.

The monthly scholarship is 5.486 DKK (approx. 730 EUR). This amount will be sufficient to cover accommodation and living costs. In addition the scolarship provides 3.000 DKK (approx. 400 EUR) to cover travel costs. VELUX scholarship candidates can borrow study books from the IBA library.

You can apply for one of the following study programmes within the VELUX Scholarship Programme. Please note – you have to choose a semester. It is NOT possible to take subjects from different semesters and study programmes.

What are the requirements?

You can apply, if:

- you have good English skills (both oral & written)

How do I apply?

If you meet the above mentioned criteria and wish to apply, you have to send the following documents to the international office at your university.

- Completed application form (with photo)
- Transcript of records (from your current study programme)
- · Copy of passport or EU ID card
- Documentation of your financial status
- Recommendation letters from your teachers
- English language exam (if you have any)
- Other relevant documentation to proove academic, social and financial status
