Държавен изпит по английски език за специалността "Химия и английски език" – бакалавър

Държавният изпит по английски език е писмен, с продължителност 3 часа.

Състои се от две части:

- 1. Тест за ниво на английски език състои се от текст за разбиране, граматика и лексика
- 2. Академичен текст по тема. Изтеглят се три теми по една от всяка секция (Лингвистика, Литература и култура, Методика на ЧЕО) от конспекта за държавен изпит.

Развиват се **две теми** - тази от секция Методика и по избор една от другите две теми.

Обемът на академичните текстове е минимум 500 думи за всяка тема - около две страници.
