Overall objective(s):

The objective of the traineeship is to carry out/assist with the planned benchmarking project for EIF's equity portfolio to best market practices.

Responsibilities:

The incumbent contributes to the development of EIF Debt Funds business plan, reporting to Carry-out / assist with the benchmarking project of EIF's portfolio of investments to best market practices, including:

- 1. the structure and level of management fees;
- 2. the level of fund manager own commitments;
- 3. assessment of the impact of increased fund size on performance;
- 4. analysis on the valuation patterns at fund manager level;

Assist with the coordination of portfolio management activities, such as:

- 1. fund manager reviews; and
- 2. portfolio reviews and reporting.

Expected outcome(s):

Provide a benchmark to best market practices project:

- to collect relevant data from various legal documentation and internal appraisal documents; and
- 2. to produce thereafter a comprehensive project report analysing the findings from (1) above.

Coordinate the portfolio management activities:

- 1. to keep up to date the master file for ERM's funds portfolio and the notes to file reviewed / post-signature events list;
- 2. to help update the relevant fund manager annual reviews.

Qualifications:

- University degree (or on-going studies at advanced stage) in Finance, Economics,
 Legal, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics or other similar fields;
- Any prior experience in banking/finance/legal would be a plus;
- Some understanding of EIF's products;
- Some knowledge and understanding of EIF's mission and activities and of markets and legal frameworks relevant to EIF business, as well as policies and priorities in that context;
- Interest in private equity funds;
- Ease with IT applications and data analyses and presentation.
