Macroeconomic and banking sector analysis and forecasts for Bulgaria are prepared in close cooperation with the office of the Chief Economist for CEE based in London and the colleagues from CEE Strategic research team in the headquarters of UCG in Vienna;
- Part of the work of the Economic Research Team is related to the preparation of regular publications, an example of which is the “CEE Macroeconomic Quarterly”, as well as the preparation of reports and presentations (which you can find on UniCredit Bulbank's website – section About Us/Results/Economic Information), with which to present the output from the respective area of research;
- The economists from the Economic Research Team take part in regular meetings with international institutions (including International Monetary Fund, Credit Rating Agencies and other fellow economists), during which the current state of Bulgarian economy and banking sector and their outlook are discussed.
