#### Brief biographical data about the applicant

Petya Stoyanova Hristova was born on 29. 04. 1973. She completed secondary education at the High School of Construction"Hristo Botev" in 1992. In 1996 she graduated higher education with Master degrees in Teacher of Physical Education and Sports Manager at the National Sports Academy "Vasil Levski", Sofia. In 1994-1996 she graduated the Programme in Sports Journalism with qualification "Editor at a sports department in newspapers, television and radio" at the National Sports Academy "Vasil Levski", Sofia.

In 2017 she was awarded the educational and scientific degree of "Doctor" in scientific field "Pedagogy", professional field 1.3 Pedagogy of education in ... (Physical Education and Sport – Aerobics), at the Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski".

She worked as a teacher in artistic gymnastics and instructor in aerobics, calanetics and fitness.

In 2014-2017 she was Assist. Prof. in professional field 1.3. (exercises in subject "sport" – aerobics and calanetics) at the Department of Sports with the Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski". Since 2017 she has been Chief Assistant in professional field 1.3. (exercises in the subject "sport" – aerobics, callanetics, low-intensity interval training, high-intensity interval training, gymnastics for proper posture and stretching) at the Department of Sports with the Sofia

University "St. Kliment Ohridski".

She is fluent in Russian and English and has excellent computer training.

## Research and applied research activities of the applicant

The scientific works submitted for the "Associate Professor" competition can be classified as follows:

- Monograph Purpose and potential of subject "Physical Education and Sport" in the higher education system of Bulgaria, ISBN 978-954-07-5353-9, reviewed.
- Articles and papers published in scientific journals, peer-reviewed and indexed in worldfamous databases of scientific information – 3 (Web of Science).
- ➢ Articles and papers published in non-indexed journals with scientific reviews or published in edited collective volumes − 11.
- Citations the list contains 5 citations.
- Projects participation in 5 successfully completed projects.
- > Of the publications, 4 are in English, the number of independent publications is 14.
