Entrance requirements

Applicants holding other BSc or MSc degrees must sit written tests for proficiency in a foreign language (English, French or German), knowledge of basic economics (a 2 page essay on a reallife economic problem) and an interview.

The EMT course of study:

This is a fulltime programme. The course of study is organized as follows:

- Students, already holding a BSc degree in Economics, Business Administration, Tourism and Finance are enrolled in 3 semester academic programme. The first two semesters include specialized disciplines The third semester is dedicated to the preparation of a master's thesis.
- Students, not holding Bachelor's degree in Economics, Administration. Business Finance or Tourism are enrolled in semester academic programme. The first two semesters make uр the foundation year of 60 ECTS credits. The subjects taught include Introduction management incl. Business planning and control, Microand Macroeconomics, Marketing, Public finance, Ouantitative methods in management, Legal management base of Organizational behaviour, HR management, Accounting, Statistics, Information systems and Corporate finance. third and the fourth semesters include the specialized disciplines. The fifth semester is dedicated to the preparation of a master's thesis.
