Conference Aspects of Work

2. Logistic technologies in manufacturing management.
3. Theory and practice of the storage-retrieval functioning management.
4. Informational technologies, models and methods in logistics.
5. Problems and modern tendencies of purchasing functioning management.
6. Customs affairs, insurance and statutory regulation in logistics.
7. Transport and logistics support of industrial complexes.
8. Students research section and poster reports (abstract and original works).

The conference will be proceeded in following formats: plenary session; sections sessions; round-table discussions; workshop sessions.

Requirements for the materials submission

The following materials in the electronic form must be submitted to the organizing committee until the **26st of March 2021** for the participation in the conference:

- the paper, prepared in accordance to the requirements;
- the application form of participant of the conference website logist.sibsau.ru.

Every paper must be in the separate file. The surname of the first author must be stated in the name of the file. The filled application form and the paper must be sent to e-mail: **konf_logistika@mail.ru**

The organizing committee reserves the right to select the sent materials. The paper will be obligatorily checked with the Anti-plagiary system. Materials will be considered for publication on the condition that they have not been published previously. Papers not corresponding the topic of the conference and of the non-compliance with deadlines, scopes and formalizations can be rejected.

After sending materials by e-mail, the message about receiving materials will be sent during the next 2 days.

Please note: By the filling the application form the author warrants that he has personally created the offered composition (paper), which is not contain illegally used materials. In case of claims and complaints about copyrights, the author will be responsible and litigate in the court.

The formalization of papers requirements

1. Content. It is necessary to define problems, to represent the target of research, achieved level of research process, the novelty of results, the field of their application.

2. Scope of the text – no longer than 6 pages of A4 size (210mm x 297mm) including tables and pictures. The margins: left and right – 2 cm, upper and lower – 2,5 cm.

3. The text, formulas and tables must be prepared in MSOffice 2003; font – TimesNewRoman, 14 pt, paragraph indentation – 0,5 cm; interline interval – single, letter and word spacing – normal, hyphenation is not allowed.

4. Formalization of the text:

Block 1

authors(s) are in the middle written in lower case (for students and post-degree students the name of the academic advisor is needed);

the name of the paper (in the middle, bold type, in upper case);

the address data of authors: organization(s), the address of organization(s), e-mail of all or one authors (if authors are from different organizations, their affiliation to the organization is marked by number (superscript) after the surname of the author and before the name of the organization);

the annotation (in italics) from the new paragraph, with the scope of 5-10 lines (author's abstract);
key words.

Block 2 – information from the Block 1 in the same sequence in English.

Block 3 – the full text of the paper in Russian or English.

Block 4 – references, links on which are contained in the text, formalized according to National State Standard P 7.0.5-2008 (for publications in Russian).

Lower on the right side must be copyright sign, surname and initials of the authors, year.

Recommendations:

- the number of authors no more than five;
- one author can be published in no more than two papers.

For conference participants information:

1. Working languages of the conference are: Russian and English.

2. The publication of the paper is free. The source book of the conference is included in RSCI (Russian Science Citation Index) data base and will be available only in the electronic form. The electronic version of the source book will be sited on the web-page of the electronic library Elibrary.ru and official SibSAU web-site in the “Science and innovation” section.

3. Both in-person and virtual participation are possible. In case of in-person participation, transportation, accommodation and food for the conference participants are at the expense of sending part. The organizing committee will contribute to accommodation in hotels of the city (we ask to make a request before 1st of March 2016).

4. The cultural program is planned for the conference participants.
