



# EIB Summer School 2024

## *Exploring the EU Climate Bank*

June 24 – 28, 2024 online

June 29 – July 6, 2024 in Luxembourg

The [EIB Group](#) is composed by the European Investment Bank and the [European Investment Fund](#). The EIB Group is the biggest [multilateral financial institution](#) in the world and one of the largest providers of climate finance. Since 2019, the EIB follows bold ambitions for climate finance to back the European Green Deal and make Europe carbon-neutral.

### Approach

The Summer School invites a group of 80 Master's students to join an online and onsite programme delivering first-hand information about the activities of the EU Climate Bank and its role in the implementation of the European Green Deal;

The academic programme includes online sessions, plenary lectures and technical seminars with four tracks focussing on either the financial, policy, technical or developmental aspects of EIB activities.

The pedagogic approach focusses on interaction, discussion, and engagement with the faculty and each other.

### Target students

Applicants should have a substantial understanding of the functioning of European institutions, a basic understanding of finance & banking, and an interest in climate & sustainability, innovation, project & infrastructure implementation, and development.

Study fields: Economics, Finance, Business, Political Science & co, Climate & Sustainability studies, Urban development, Development studies, Law\*, Engineering\*.

### Application

The selection process for participation to the EIB Summer School is primarily managed by the partner university. The EIB Institute supports an inclusive selection process with special regards, but not limited to, nationality, gender and disability. This means that any necessary measures of reasonable accommodation shall be provided in the selection process as derived from the UNCRPD, which is binding on all MSs and the EU itself.

### Requirements

- Master's student
- Under 32 years of age

**Please note:** While non-EU citizens are welcome to join the EIB Summer School, most EIB positions are only open to nationals EU Member States and EU candidate countries – as stated in the [eligibility criteria of the EIB](#).

### Fees

There are no attendance fees for the Summer School. Board and accommodation of the entire official program are covered by the EIB. Participants are expected to cover their travel expenses as well as costs for non-official social activities.
